Scholarships for Centre of Excellence

Dear Member Associations,

We would like to inform you that Badminton Europe has decided to continue the scholarship program for the BEC Centre of Excellence (BEC COE) in 2018. The scholarships allow players to come and train at the BEC COE for a period of 1 or 2 weeks. The scholarship program will run from 3 January to 21 December 2018.

A scholarship consists out of free accommodation, free lunch and dinner, training, coaching and shuttlecocks. Breakfast is organised with the BEC COE players and will be eaten at the accommodation. Players will have to cover their travel to the BEC COE. Players who travel by plane will have to take the train from the airport to Holbæk station where they will be picked up and brought to the BEC COE.

Singles players are invited to apply for Badminton Europe scholarships.

Criteria

The Criteria to be eligible for a Badminton Europe scholarship are either:

- to be placed in top 50 in singles on the World Junior Ranking
- to be placed in top 300 in singles on the World Ranking

Scholarships will be awarded on an open application scheme until 21 December 2018. Please complete the attached nomination form as soon as the preferred training dates are known.
